Intro – This is "Holy Week" – from Palm Sunday to Resurrection Sunday Triumphal Entry/Palm Sunday (Psalm 118) – read Matt 21:1-11 Disciples find unbroken colt; Jesus entry into Jerusalem (pix)

Many Jewish people thought Jesus will overthrow the Roman govt; bring justice; voice will bring peace; take over the govt; we're thrilled!! Hosanna! I am trying to imagine more what it looked like back in Jesus time, when everyone came together and praised the Messiah, Jesus!

Also this week Wed begins "Passover". Passover is April 8-16 (8 days). For many years, I've believed Christians should learn a lot more about Passover. Refer to Exodus 12; read Mark 14:17-28

Expert doctors are predicting this will be one of the worst weeks people get CV; deaths; maybe some of your own friends or family will die; pray now to prepare! - 3) Clean your home of dust time to follow Jewish ways. Starting with me!!

THEN we will truly be prepared for next week — Resurrection Sunday celebration with Lord's Supper (communion)!!

Prayer – 3 P's – teach us to <u>Praise</u>, <u>Passover</u>, <u>Prepare</u> our hearts (rid of sin)
